Vaccination Policy

The following vaccination requirements apply to all enrolled students at the String Theory School of Design. These standards are designed to promote public health and ensure a safe learning environment.

Required Immunizations

- Four (4) doses of tetanus, diphtheria, and acellular pertussis (DTP/DTaP/DT/Td), with at least one dose administered on or after the fourth birthday.
- Four (4) doses of poliovirus vaccine, with the fourth dose given on or after the fourth birthday and at least six months after the previous dose (unless the third dose was given on or after age four and at least six months after the prior dose).
- Two (2) doses of measles vaccine (commonly as MMR).
- Two (2) doses of mumps vaccine (commonly as MMR).
- Two (2) doses of rubella vaccine (commonly as MMR).
- Three (3) doses of hepatitis B vaccine.
- Two (2) doses of varicella (chickenpox) vaccine or documented evidence of immunity.

Tuberculosis Screening

All students must complete a tuberculosis (TB) risk screening questionnaire. Testing is required if indicated by the screening.

Exemptions

Students may request exemption on the basis of:

- **Medical contraindication**, with certification by a licensed healthcare provider, or
- **Sincerely held religious or moral beliefs**, with a written statement of objection.

Outbreak Exclusion

Students granted exemptions may be excluded from classes or in-person learning activities during an identified outbreak of a vaccine-preventable disease.
